Going to "Big School" - If your child is off to big school or leaving to attend another state nursery in September please remember that we need to have your final days' notice in writing 30 days before they leave and that you need to contact your bank to cancel your standing order for the following month before the 20th. Names - Please, please, please can you put your children's names in all of their jackets, coats, hats, etc as quite often the children will come in wearing the same items.

Photo orders - All photo orders have now been given out, If there are any problems with your order, please can you contact Tempest directly as they will not let us deal with parent orders once received - thanks

Sun cream - Can you please ensure that during the hot weather you do the following so ensure your child is kept safe in the sun:

- 1. Your child comes in with sun cream already applied so it has time to work into the skin.
- 2. That children staying for full morning/afternoon sessions (5 hours) have sun cream left at Nursery so we can re-apply it as the day progresses

Can you also ensure your child brings a sun hat with them to protect their head.

Shoes - Can we also ask that you do not put your children in strappy sandals for nursery as although they look very pretty they are not very practical for running around and digging in the garden and we find that they can cause the children to fall over quite frequently. Thank you

Session times - Could you please make sure that you adhere to the session times booked for you child/ren as our staff rota's are put in place based on the number of children in at these times - this means that if you are late collecting your child then a team member may have to work additional time in order to ensure we do not fall below our legal staffing ratios.

State nursery applications - We are unfortunately no longer taking bookings for just state nursery sessions due to increased numbers in the rest of the nursery - these sessions can now only be accessed as part of our normal sessions if your child is attending 3+ sessions per week.
